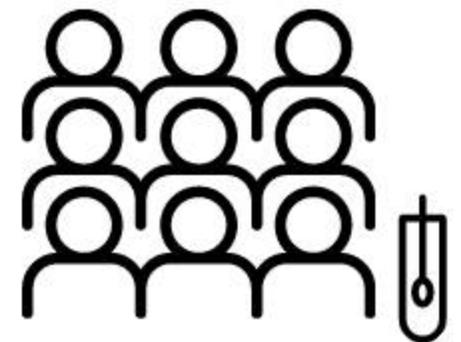


**WHAT DOES A
SYSTEMATIC
NATIONAL TESTING
PLAN LOOK LIKE?**



1. FREE MASS TESTING

- Implemented by the government across locations to detect active cases
- “Point of interaction” testing e.g. in entrances of factories and office spaces
- Number of daily tests carried out must be correlated with the number of positive cases and positivity rate





2. SUBSIDISE RTK & SELF-TEST KITS

Make testing accessible and available to all and encourage regular work-place screening





3. DIGITALISE TESTING & CONTACT TRACING

- For preventive testing, use AI-enabled hotspot detecting technology
- For contact tracing, use robust IT infrastructure with near-real-time alerts to citizens. MySejahtera should be equipped with an automated case notification system





4. MONITOR PATIENTS DURING ISOLATION PHASE

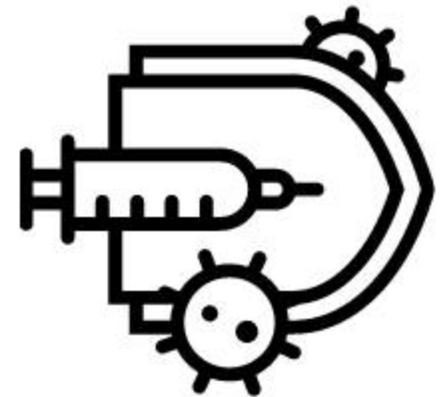
Provide end-to-end support with constant health updates

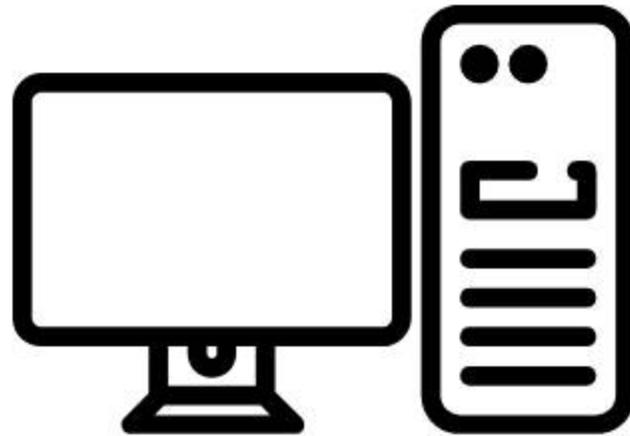




5. ENSURE NO-ONE GETS LEFT BEHIND
